New Alumni Mentor Program to Launch This Month

To the Phi Delta Theta Community:



As President of the NC Beta Foundation (the House Corporation of the UNC-Chapel Hill Phi Delta Theta Fraternity), I am pleased to report that 2016 Fall Rush was highly successful, with the initiation of 27 new Brothers hailing from North Carolina, Virginia, Florida, Colorado, Texas, and Tennessee. The current chapter now has 85 members and five affiliates in total, and continues to be engaged in numerous philanthropic endeavors including the Eve Carson Memorial 5K for Education, Cookout to Knockout

ALS, and the first annual Luke Garrison Memorial Golf Tournament, which took place last April. Numerous Brothers are also involved in leadership roles within many campus organizations including student government, the Carolina Challenge venture competition, the Kenan-Flagler undergraduate business program, and a new ethics awareness program called Carolina Conscious.

I am particularly excited about a new endeavor involving both active and alumni Brothers. Over the course of discussion with the active chapter, we realized that there has not been an organized avenue for alumni and active Brothers to connect on career development.
